Can I take another opportunity to thank you for your patience and understanding over the issues with the drains which led to the partial closure of the school.

I am aware that some new parents were not on Ping when the last newsletter came out so there are a number of repeated messages in this newsletter.

A huge thank you to those of you who joined us for the Meet the Teacher sessions over the last 2 weeks. I hope you found the sessions useful, but we are keen to offer sessions to support parents in the future. A few parents have mentioned that sessions on Seesaw, Read Write Inc. and numeracy/maths approaches would be useful. Please let us know if there is anything else you think would be of use in the future. The presentations which were used by the teachers will be placed on the website by next Monday.

The term is now well under way and the children are all working really hard. Wellbeing days are as popular as ever and we also celebrated Roald Dahl Day last week. A highlight as always was the day that Reception pupils met their Year 6 buddies. Year 6 support Reception children in a number of ways including coming into singing and celebration worships.





Harvest

As in previous years we will be collecting harvest donations for The Vale Foodbank and I am sure you will agree this is a very worthy cause. Members of The Foodbank will be coming into school to explain to the children all about their work and we will be holding our special Harvest service in school. If you would like to contribute to the collection, we will be collecting for the foodbank during the week of Monday 2nd October. (Please do not send in items before this date as we have issues with storage). They have specifically asked us to collect UHT milk, biscuits and dried instant noodles. Many thanks for your support with this.

Church Visits and Class Worships

In previous years, we have invited children to take part in the service at St Peter's Church at 10:30 on Sundays. The children's teacher will prepare with the children in school and then we ask parents to bring the children to church on the day. Throughout the year, different classes will have the opportunity to present to the congregation. We will also be inviting parents into school on particular days throughout the year to join us in our class worships. The dates for all of these is in the list at the end of the newsletter.

Message from Father Andrew

Confirmation classes for year 5 and up are starting on Sunday the 1st October at 4pm in St Peters church. Bishop Mary will be coming to St Peters on the 5th November at 3pm to take the confirmation service.

School Car Park and Lay-by

For safety reasons, we do not allow parents/carers to park in the layby or school car park. The only exception to this is for breakfast club before 8:15 and then for After School Club after 4.30pm. Also, please use the pedestrian path and gate rather than cutting through the car park. Many thanks for your cooperation with this.

Safeguarding at pick up

At pick up at the end of the day, we are seeing parents standing by the fence and beckoning their children to come to them, rather than queuing. This is becoming increasingly difficult for teachers who are trying to dismiss children safely to parents/carers. For this reason, from now on, these children will be dismissed last so if you do not wish to join the queue, or have a dog, I am afraid you will need to wait until the majority of children have been collected by their parents/carers.

Snacks and drinks (Repeated message)

We only allow fresh fruit or vegetables as a snack in both the infants and juniors. Rice cakes, nuts, cereal bars and other snacks are not permitted, and staff will ask the pupils to return them to their bags. We also expect water only in drinks bottles. Whilst the contents of lunch boxes are for you to decide, we do not allow any fizzy drinks, bars of chocolate or sweets in lunch boxes. Please remember to peel oranges and place in a box if your child cannot do so. Please ensure all snack pots, lunch boxes and water bottles are also labelled. All children (with the exception of Nursery who use cups) need a water bottle in school please – including those who have school lunch or grab bags. However, please rest assured, if your child forgets their bottle, we will ensure they have access to a drink throughout the day.

Information on Safeguarding of Children (Repeated message)

If you have concerns about the safety or well-being of a child in our school, you are encouraged to report your concerns. The Designated Safeguarding Officer for the school is myself whilst Mrs. Bayliss is the Deputy Safeguarding Officer. If you feel unable to talk to us, the Governor with responsibility for Safeguarding is Mrs. Amy Hurst. Every member of staff has had relevant training and will deal with issues sensitively and appropriately. There is information on the board next to the office about Safeguarding contacts which also includes the contact number for Children's Services. If ever you were unsure, you can always phone the police too. Our Safeguarding policy is available on our website.

Information on Complaints Procedures (Repeated message)

A complaint is defined in our school policy as 'serious concern, grievance or dissatisfaction'. If you do have a complaint, the first point of contact where possible should always be the class teacher. If you feel your complaint has not been dealt with then obviously you can speak to me, Mrs Bayliss or

a governor. If you are still not satisfied, then a written complaint can be submitted to the governing body. This policy is also available on our website.

Contacting school (Repeated message)

If you do have questions or concerns about your child's learning then teachers can be emailed on the addresses below. Please note the following:

- I do not expect teachers to reply to emails outside of normal 'office hours' or weekends/holidays. In a job-share class, it could be either teacher who responds, depending on their contracted days of work.
- Teachers are teaching all day and may not pick up an email until after school. Anything urgent should therefore be directed to the school email address.
- Anything to do with admin **must** be directed to the school email account. This includes illness, absence, medication, allergies, changes of contact details, uniform, parentpay etc.
